

	<p><u>Building:</u> A 2½ story Brutalist style structure having a flat roof, flushboard siding, and a wide variety of window shapes and sizes. The facade has three rectangular bands of windows and the garage entry is also on the facade. Note the large exterior (metal) chimney stack. The south elevation has large square windows. The foundation is poured concrete.</p>

	19 HISTORICAL OR ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE	
<p><u>Historical:</u> New Haven Building Department Records indicate that this house was erected in 1971 for Frank Pannenberg at a cost of \$40,000.</p> <p><u>Architectural:</u> This Brutalist-style house is the only post-modern structure in the entire neighborhood and stands out of place, among the other early 20th century Colonial Revival style houses.</p>
