DESCRIPTION (Continued)

Building: A one story, concrete block modern house with an "E" shape floor plan which forms a series of courts. The roof shape is flat. Large sliding glass doors are present throughout the house. The sprawling house fills the long urban lot of land on which it was built. A tall wood fence encloses the "front yard" and hides the house from the street.

19 HISTORICAL OR ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE

Historical: This house was built for and designed by Serge Chermayeff in 1962.

Architecture: An example of Modern-Minimalist architecture. According to Don Metz, Chermayeff designed the house "as a variation of the architect's comprehensively developed proposals for medium-density, cluster prototypes." The "E" shape besides creating an interesting mix of interior and exterior spaces, has the utilitarian purpose of dividing the house into sections according to function.
